





- Helps over **41 million** low-income individuals in the US put food on the table



### H.R.1276 – a positive vision of how the Farm Bill should strengthen SNAP

Congress should strengthen SNAP by passing the "Closing the Meal Gap Act" (H.R. 1276) to:







Offer employment & training opportunities to jobless adults before time limiting their SNAP benefits

Boost SNAP benefits for families with children forced to choose between food & shelter Boost SNAP benefits for older Americans forced to choose between food & medicine



Boost the SNAP minimum monthly benefit to \$25 per month



Base SNAP benefits on the more adequate Low-Cost Food Plan
