

Most recently, Kanav Bhagat was a Director of Research for the JPMorgan Chase Institute, where he led a team using the administrative data of JP Morgan Chase & Co to conduct housing finance and financial markets research designed to help policymakers, business leaders, and non-profit decision makers make more informed policy choices. While at the Institute, he developed and executed a research agenda focused on mortgage underwriting, performance, modification, and refinancing, as well as monetary policy transmission mechanisms and central bank communication.

Previously, Kanav served as the Global Head of Rates Trading at J.P. Morgan, where he managed a global team of 150 traders who were responsible for the trading, risk-management, and capital management of securities, interest rate swaps, options, and exotics in G10 interest rate markets. Kanav was a key part of the Macro Products Trading Management Team (comprised of Rates, FX, Emerging Markets, and Commodities Trading), and has a broad set of experiences across the major fixed income markets. In this role, he was a key advisor to many of J.P. Morgan's priority institutional clients, including asset managers, mortgage servicers, insurance companies, banks, and hedge funds.

Prior to this engagement, Kanav was the Global Head of Non-Linear Trading, and previously the Global Head of Interest Rate Options Trading. He joined J.P. Morgan in 2006 to run USD Interest Rate Options Trading. Prior to joining J.P. Morgan, he held the same position at Credit Suisse. Kanav began his career in financial markets at Lehman Brothers in 1998, where he traded USD interest rate options.

Kanav earned a B.S. in Electrical Engineering from Cornell University and an M.B.A. from the University Of Chicago Graduate School Of Business. He is originally from Silver Spring, Maryland.
